GK Fit Ltd has adopted this Privacy policy and expects its employees to support it and comply with it.

The type of personal information we collect

We currently collect and process the following information:

- Personal identifiers, contacts and characteristics (eg. name and contact details)
- Medical, SEND and other relevant information of young people that participate in our activities

How we get the personal information and why we have it

Most of the personal information we process is provided to us directly by you for one of the following reasons:

- To make a booking with us
- To stay updated about activities and sessions from us
- To inform us of any Medical, SEND and other relevant needs of participants
- To comply with our First Aid policy.

We use the information that you have given us in order to take bookings or payment, notify of any changes or new activities and to contact you in an emergency.

Under the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR), the lawful bases we rely on for processing this information are:

- (a) Your consent. You are able to remove your consent at any time. You can do this by emailing info@gkfit.co.uk
- (b) We have a contractual obligation
- (c) We have a legal obligation
- (d) We have a vital interest
- (e) We need it to perform a public task
- (f) We have a legitimate interest

How we store your personal information

Your information will be held digitally and securely on cloud-based storage which will be password protected. GK Fit Ltd will have sole access to this information and will retain indefinitely, unless you ask us to delete them. You can do this by emailing info@gkfit.co.uk

Your data protection rights

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

- Your right of access - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information.
- Your right to rectification - You have the right to ask us to rectify personal information you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.
- Your right to erasure - You have the right to ask us to erase your personal information in certain circumstances.
- Your right to restriction of processing - You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.
- Your right to object to processing - You have the right to object to the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.
- Your right to data portability - You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal information you gave us to another organisation, or to you, in certain circumstances.

You are not required to pay any charge for exercising your rights. If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you.
